### Sports Grant (SG) received 2019-2020

### Objectives in spending Sports Grant 2018-2019

- To help support three permanent sports coaches and one part-time Saturday football coach
- To encourage active play during break times and lunchtimes
- To establish, extend or fund attendance of school sport clubs and activities
- To develop and extend involvement in competitive sport

### Outcomes to date

- Most pupils engage in supervised sport activities every playtime & lunchtime
- Seven after-school weekly sports clubs established covering a variety of sports for N - Year 6
- High levels of participation in after school sports clubs
- Three competitive football teams maintained - including one girls - with weekly training sessions
- Weekly training sessions established for younger pupils to feed into main football teams - including girls
- Hill Mead continues to top the two football leagues in which we play

**Plans for spending in current school year 2019-2020**

- To continue supporting three full-time permanent sports coaches
- To continue to fund a part-time sports coach to train and support Saturday football league
- To maintain the high levels of engagement in sports activities at playtimes and lunchtimes
- Further to expand the number of weekly after-school sports clubs offered
- Successfully to take part in at least one girls football league
