Dear parents and carers,

Phased reopening of the school - Letter 3

We are preparing to reopen the school for **Nursery, Reception, Year 1** and **Year 6** from **Monday 8th June** at the earliest.

Next week (beginning 1st June), we will contact the families concerned, to confirm attendance. You will not be sanctioned if you do not want your child to come to school.

The voucher scheme for school lunches will continue for any qualifying pupil who remains at home. The home-learning activities will continue to be available for all year groups.

We will put the following **safety measures** in place

Social distancing

- Pupils will stay in small groups of 15, and with the same staff at all times.
- Pupils will be spread out across the classroom, lunch hall or playground.
- Play and lunch times will be staggered to avoid contact between different pupil groups.
- Pupil groups will start and end the school day at different times.

Cleaning & hygiene

- Each pupil group will share with one other pupil group in the same age range:
 - Designated toilets.
 - Their own cleaner throughout the day, focusing on the toilets and common or frequently touched surfaces.

- Resources that cannot easily be cleaned, will be removed from the classroom or playground.
- Frequent handwashing will be scheduled, particularly at the start & end of the day, and when moving to & from the classroom, lunch hall & playground.

Finally, please remember that the school will only reopen if our full risk assessment has been approved by the National Education Union, and by our Governing Body.
