### **Phased reopening of the school**

We are preparing to reopen the school for **Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 6.**

This may be as soon as Monday, 1st June, depending on confirmation by the government. I'd like to reassure you that whatever the date, we will only reopen when we have carried out a detailed risk assessment, and only if this assessment has been approved by the National Education Union and by our Governing Body.

Whenever the school reopens, it will be your decision whether or not to send your children in. You will not be sanctioned for non-attendance at this time. The voucher scheme for school lunches will continue for any qualifying pupil who remains at home. The home-learning activities will continue to be available for all year groups.

I will write to you again next week with details of the safety measures and adaptations we will be putting in place.
